

2021 Updated Rules
Crestwood Hills Pool and Recreation Center

1. No weapons of any kind are allowed
2. Foul Language is not allowed
3. Aggressive Behavior both verbally and physically (including rough horseplay) is not allowed
4. Excessive displays of affection is not allowed
5. Intoxication on the premises is not allowed
6. Smoking, vaping or use of any illegal substances is not allowed on the premises
7. The lot behind the tennis court is off limits unless utilized for parking for events
8. After hours use of the grounds is by permission only and may be treated as trespassing.
9. Treat the property and other people's belongings with respect. No destructive behavior. (Breaking items, graffiti, climbing fences, sitting/standing on tables, vandalism.
10. No chairs in the baby pool.
11. No walking on the white guttering area surrounding the pool.
12. Please label your belongings. Lost and found will be cleared Sunday night.
13. No food or drink on the tennis courts
14. Please pick up after yourself and do not leave trash behind for others to clean.
15. Obey instructions of the lifeguards and management at all times. Please correct behavior if asked to do so. Unattended minors unwilling to follow rules of the pool, may be sent home after parent/guardian contact. Ongoing behavioral problems may result in the inability to attend without parent/guardian supervision.
16. Floats may only be in the pool during designated hours on Fridays, unless Coast Guard approved floatation device for young swimmers.
17. Minors may not be left unattended if they cannot safely swim without a floatation device.
18. In the event of thunder, the pools, pool deck and fence must be cleared immediately. The manager on duty will determine according to policy when it is safe to return to pools and pool deck. It is recommended that members and guests who wish to stay wait in their vehicles for the weather to clear. If a vehicle is not available, the clubhouse is the safest place to take cover. Waiting in the large and small pavilion is not recommended and pavilions should be cleared. Closing the premises due to foul weather is at the discretion of the manager on duty. Updates regarding closings will be placed on Facebook member page.
19. Pets are not allowed inside gated area unless they are documented service animals and properly identified and approved at the office. A copy of documentation needs to be provided to the office to keep on file.
20. Please follow all rules as listed on posted signs
21. Please initial in the top right corner that all of these rules have been reviewed with household members who will attend the pool.
